- Budget for 2018-2019 School Year
 - Smencils fundraiser will be held twice this year.
 - Breakdown of how donations were used:
 - MakerBot 3D printer: \$1,925.29
 - 1 School, 1 Book Event: \$1,000
 - Outdoor ed t-shirts for 5th graders: \$675
 - Outdoor classroom: \$1,500
 - Assemblies: \$1,600
 - 85 books for new teachers: \$733.70
 - Class parties: \$632.90
 - Family fun nights (Blackberry Farm, Halloween, etc.): \$1,222.26
 - Field day: \$1,012.53
 - Grade level wish lists: \$5,060.40
